SUBJECT: For possible action: Canvass of returns and certification of the abstract for the June 11, 2019 Municipal General Election

Business Impact Statement: This action will not have a significant economic impact on business and will not directly restrict the formation, operation, or expansion of a business.

Action Requested: That the City Council consider canvass the Municipal General Election returns and direct the City Clerk to certify the abstract for the June 11, 2019 Municipal General Election and transmit to the Secretary of State.

Overview:

- The General Election was held on June 11, 2019.
- The unofficial final results are attached.
- The official returns will be provided upon receipt from the Clark County Election Department prior to the meeting

Background Information:

NRS 293C.387 requires the City Council to canvass returns and approve the official abstract of votes within six working days from the election.

In completing the canvass of the returns, the Council shall:

- Note separately any clerical errors discovered; and
- Take account of the changes resulting from the discovery, so that the result declared represents the true vote cast

After the City Council completes the canvass and declares the results, the next step is for the City Clerk to certify the official abstract to the Secretary of State's office.

There were 4,714 voters casting ballots.

For the office of Mayor, Mayor Woodbury received 2,131 votes; Council member McManus received 2,527 votes. Therefore, Council member McManus has been elected to serve as Mayor.

For the office of Council member, James Howard Adams received 2,246 votes; Claudia Bridges received 2,513 votes, Council member Peggy Leavitt received 2,207 votes; and Council member Rich Shuman received 1,528 votes. James Howard Adams and Claudia Bridges have been elected to serve as Council members.

The Mayor and Council members will be sworn into office at the June 25, 2019 regular meeting of the City Council.
