Payment is due prior to services rendered. If an account falls into a non-prepaid status, a three day grace period at a “drop in” rate of \$12 for 1/2 day and \$24 for full day will apply. An account past due after the three day “drop in” grace period may be subject to a \$20 late fee. The Safekey program ends at 6pm. For every ten minutes your child is not picked up beginning at 6:01pm, a late fee of \$10 will be assessed. Late payment is due at the time of pickup. Payments are accepted at the 900 Arizona Street office M-Th 7am-6pm.

The schedule below represents the types of activities your child will be engaged in each day. The schedule is adjusted according to the children's interest. Each day, your child is required to be signed in and out of the program by a parent or parent approved individual. On field trip days, sign in and out procedures may be adjusted as needed, and additional fees may apply. *Upon approaching the building, please check the sign at the top of the stairs located on the east side of the Recreation Department to identify where the program is located within the facility/community for dropping off and picking up your child.*

Field Trip transportation space may be limited. Field trips are available on a first come, first serve basis. Children 60lbs. and under require a booster seat provided by the family. The entire Safekey program may be off site during the field trip hours identified on this calendar. Call 702-287-6154 to verify that staff is available at the Recreation Center to accept drop ins. Please pay your field trip fees directly to the Safekey staff in cash. Field Trips are subject to change. *Out of town field trip registration & payments are accepted the Monday prior to the field trip date. All other field trips are paid on the date of the event. Please provide exact field trip funds as Safekey does not have a bank.*

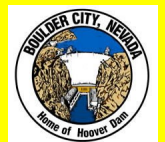
