The Family Assistance Center & Family Reunification Center is now open at the Las Vegas Convention Center, Exhibit Hall S-2.

- The 24- hour facility will operate until further notice. Family members of victims who are believed to have died in the incident are invited to the center by appointment only. The center is staffed with professionals and volunteers trained to provide mental health support and guidance through the legal processes of death notifications, personal effects distribution and the provision of memorial services.
