Boulder City Police Department participates in *Joining Forces* DUI campaign

BOULDER CITY - The Boulder City Police Department is joining other Nevada law enforcement agencies to emphasize the importance of safe and sober driving as we approach the Labor Day Holiday weekend.

Through Monday, September 10, Boulder City Police Department will dedicate extra officers to DUI enforcement as part of a statewide *Joining Forces* campaign aimed at reducing tragedies caused by people driving under the influence.

Funding for the extra patrols needed for this campaign is made possible by a *Joining Forces* grant received from the Nevada Department of Public Safety/Office of Traffic Safety.

Joining Forces is a multi-jurisdictional law enforcement program aimed at reducing injuries and crashes through statewide enforcement in the areas of: DUI, speed, distracted driving, seat belt and pedestrian safety.

The goal of these enforcement campaigns is to save lives by increasing public awareness about the dangers of making poor choices while driving.
