Boulder City Employee Receives Top Tech Exec Award

BOULDER CITY – Boulder City’s Special Projects Coordinator Brok Armantrout was named a winner in the Las Vegas Top Tech Exec Awards 2018 for his exceptional leadership coordinating technology improvements benefiting the city and its residents.

“We are all very proud of the amazing work Brok has done at the city and I’m thrilled he’s received this well-deserved award from his peers in Southern Nevada,” said Al Noyola, City Manager of Boulder City. “Brok has always been on the forefront of technological advancements to help Boulder City succeed.”

The awards were presented at a ceremony Nov. 1 at the Smith Center for the Performing Arts. The 2018 Top Tech Exec Awards are a partnership between Cox Business and VEGAS, INC to celebrate excellence among Southern Nevada technology officials. Nominated by his peers, Brok was recognized with the Government Award. He was instrumental in prompting the project to connect city facilities and add high-speed connections. The project allowed the city to move its network servers to cloud services, creating a recovery option in case of a critical event.

“It was a tremendous honor just to be recognized with a nomination among such a dynamic and brilliant group of Southern Nevadans” said Armantrout, who started at Boulder City in 2004 and was named Contracts Manager in 2017. “I would like to thank all the hard working people at Boulder City for making the technology projects so successful.”

“Brok brings an enthusiasm to his work every day, and I appreciate the institutional knowledge he provides in his work,” said Brok’s supervisor Diane Pelletier, Finance Director. This award is a great honor and recognition.”

In its eighth year, the Top Tech Exec Awards are judged by top technology officials in local government, education, gaming and business and highlights the vital work of these forward thinking individuals whose efforts strive to make everyone’s life better. Awards were also presented in categories such as Lifetime Achievement, Community Exemplary, Health Care and Education.
