LA Department of Water and Power Building to Get a New Old Look

A noticeable change will be coming to a local landmark over the next few months. The Los Angeles Department of Water and Power Building, at 600 Nevada Way, will get a fresh, new coat of paint, but with a nod to the past.

Originally known as the Los Angeles Bureau of Power and Light Building, the structure has been painted many times and has been many colors over the years. To honor its historic roots, the City of Boulder City recently performed a forensic-paint analysis to help determine which of those colors came first.

The study determined that the body of the building was Biscuit (SW6112) and the trim was Creamery (SW6358). Those are the colors to which the building will return when the contractor completes the job sometime within the next three months.

The contractor will strip and remove old paint in accordance with lead-based paint removal standards. This may result in limited access to the immediate area around the building during some portions of the work.
