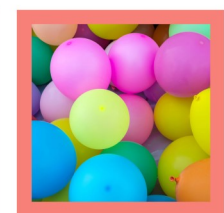
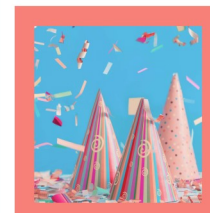




What's Happening around the City of Boulder City

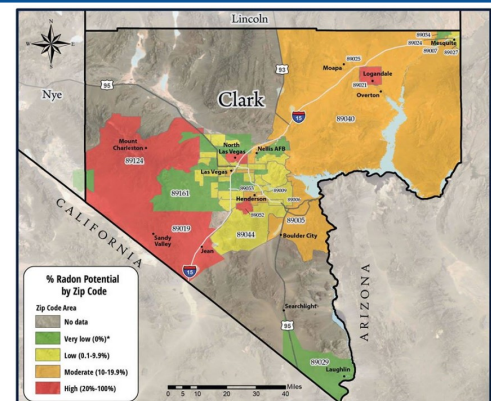
Celebrating 60 Years!

The Boulder City Chamber of Commerce will be holding a celebration of the 60th Anniversary of our Incorporation on Saturday, January 4 at 6:00 p.m. in the Boulder City Recreation Center, 900 Arizona Street. In 1958, Congress approved the Boulder City Act and after 29 years of federal control, the Bureau of Reclamation transferred ownership of approximately 33 square miles to Boulder City's new government. Boulder City received the quitclaim deed, dated January 4, 1960 and therefore, was incorporated. The City's territory increased with the acquisition of an additional 167 square miles of former federal land in 1995, and again in 2009 with the annexation of 6.5 square miles of federal land, bringing the total area within the City's limits to approximately 207 square miles. January is Radon Action Month

Radon is a colorless, odorless, and tasteless radioactive gas that occurs naturally in most rocks and soils. It is produced by the breakdown of uranium in soil, rock and water. Radon is harmlessly dispersed in outdoor air, but when trapped in buildings it can build up, increasing the risk of lung cancer. Boulder City has an elevated risk of radon.
