CALL TO ORDER

The meeting of the Boulder City Audit Review Committee, County of Clark, State of Nevada, was called to order at 1:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 3, 2018, in the Large Conference Room by Member Shuman in due compliance with law, with the following members present, namely:

PUBLIC COMMENT

Member Shuman opened the Public Comment period for matters pertaining to items on the agenda.

No further comments were offered and the Public Comment period was closed.

1. For possible action: Approval of the minutes of the November 30, 2017 Audit Review Committee meeting

Member McManus moved to approve the November 30, 2017 minutes; seconded by Member Shuman; unanimously approved.

2. For possible action: Discussion and recommendation to the City Council regarding the selection of auditor for five years beginning with audit of Boulder City for Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2018

A staff report had been submitted by Finance Director Diane Pelletier and included in the April 3, 2018, Audit Review Committee Agenda Packet.

Finance Director Pelletier reviewed the process for the selection of an audit firm. She said a Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued on February 1, 2018 and the City had received five responses. She said she and Chief Accountant Doug Honey had individually ranked the responses and they had chosen the same top two firms. She stated they had called references and had received excellent feedback regarding the firm of HintonBurdick CPA's & Advisors. She said the firm had provided services to Mesquite and Fernley, communities of similar size to Boulder City. She said both entities spoke highly of the firm. She said she had called HintonBurdick and had spoken for approximately 45 minutes regarding the audit process. She said she wanted to ensure the City would be a top priority. She noted the price of services was in the middle; it was not the most expensive and it was not the least expensive.

In response to Member McManus, Finance Director Pelletier confirmed the proposed contract would be for a five-year period with two potential option years. She said throughout her career she has taken great care in evaluating audit firms.

Member McManus stated he had the opportunity to look over the responses to the RFP. He said the recommended firm offered training opportunities and were willing to work closely with staff on compliance issues.

In response to a question by Chairman Shuman, Finance Director Pelletier stated the firm would meet with the Audit Review Committee prior to the commencement of the audit.

Chairman Shuman stated each year the committee had met with the auditors it had made the request to meet more frequently.

Finance Director Pelletier agreed and stated the firm had a portal where information could be exchanged. She said it would not be necessary for the firm to always be on site.

Chairman Shuman stated the importance of being proactive. He said some audit issues have been small and correctable.

Community member Ross Wright noted the previous audit firm had prepared the City's financial statements and essentially auditing their own work.

Finance Director Pelletier stated she was surprised to learn the financial statements had been prepared by the audit firm. She said with the City's staff shortage, it would be almost impossible for staff to prepare the entire report. She said it was common in small communities for auditors to help prepare the reports.

In response to a question by Member McManus, Finance Director Pelletier stated there were no foreseeable problems importing data. She said she advised the firm of the financial software the City used and was assured there would be no problem.

In response to a question by Member McManus, Finance Director Pelletier stated the new firm would review past audits and reach out to the City's former auditor; it was part of its due diligence.

Chairman Shuman thanked the Finance Department for its due diligence.

MOTION: Concur with the Finance Department's recommendation to enter into agreement with HintonBurdick CPA's & Advisors.

Moved by Chairman Shuman; seconded by Member McManus; unanimously approved.

3. Public Comment

No comments were offered.

There being no further business to come before the Audit Review Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 1:13 p.m.
