FREE YOUTH SPORTS AND YOUTH SWIMMING POOL ENTRY!

City Council approved a measure to provide funding so that kids can join youth sports and swim (during open swim hours) **FREE OF CHARGE THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2024!***

The City of Boulder City received American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic. Funds can be utilized for a wide range of uses, including infrastructure investments, public safety and programs that respond to the harm caused by social isolation during the pandemic.



To give local families a financial break, promote physical activity, and keep youth connected with peers, City Council voted on April 7, 2022 to waive fees for Boulder City Municipal recreational youth sports and youth pool entry during open swim hours.

Primary Municipal Election

Starting in 2022, Nevada will have all-mail ballot elections. Boulder City voters who are active and registered to vote no later than 14 days before Election Day will be sent a mail ballot.

BALLOT DROP-OFF

Voters may also drop off voted mail ballots in-person at any Early Voting Site during the dates and hours listed in the schedule. You must still sign the outside of the postage-paid return envelope provided specifically for you, showing your name and address, and seal your voted ballot inside of this envelope before you deposit it in the drop box (do not put your ballot in another voter's return envelope).

WATER RATES CORRECTION:

SNWA Charges WILL NOT INCREASE IN Boulder City in July

The Southern Nevada Water Authority's (SNWA) charges paid by Boulder City customers WILL NOT BE increasing in July. Last month, we reported in the Utility Bill that Boulder City residents would be charged an average \$1.79 more due to higher infrastructure and pass through charges. SNWA has confirmed that they are not increasing Boulder City's charges at this time.
