[Airport Advisory Committee](#) - The Airport Advisory Committee advises City Council and the City Manager on matters concerning the Master Plan.

[Allotment Committee](#) - The Allotment Committee was created by the Growth Control Ordinance.

[Charter Commission](#) - Advises City Council on all matters affecting the Charter of Boulder City, Nevada, including amendments. Charter Commission members serve three year terms.

[Civil Service Commission](#) - The Civil Service Commission prepares and adopts rules and regulations to govern the selection and appointment of all employees.

[Combined Board of Appeals](#) - Members of the Combined Board of Appeals serve four year terms.

[Golf Course Green Committee](#) - The Golf Course Green Committee advises on matters concerning the Boulder City Golf Course.

[Historic Preservation Committee](#) - The Historic Preservation Committee advises the Planning Commission and City Council to aid property owners in maintaining and enhancing the worthwhile historical resources of Boulder City.

[Parks & Recreation Commission](#) - The Parks and Recreation Commission acts in an advisory capacity to the City Council, Planning Commission, City Manager and Parks and Recreation Director. Members meet every other month.

[Planning Commission](#) - This committee conducts public hearings and makes determinations on matters pertaining to the Zoning Ordinance.
