## Joining Forces for Safer Roads



Boulder City Police Department (BCPD) is “Joining Forces” to make our roads safer for drivers. The “Joining Forces” campaign is a high visibility, multi-jurisdictional statewide effort to increase safety on Nevada’s roads by increasing enforcement and awareness of traffic laws. Through January 22, 2019, more than two dozen law enforcement agencies statewide are cracking down on drivers exceeding speed limits or driving too fast for road conditions. Numerous police agencies will be conducting extra patrol on Interstate 11 and US-95 within the city limits of Boulder City during this period. Drivers are urged to slow down and drive with caution so they can arrive alive. Driving 10 mph over the posted speed limit will only decrease a 300-mile trip by approximately 30 minutes. However, it may result in you getting pulled over and cited which will take roughly 10 minutes and cost a couple hundred dollars.
