## **Know the Watering Restrictions**



The community's mandatory spring seasonal watering schedule, which limits landscape irrigation to three assigned days per week, is now in effect through April 30. The restrictions apply to both turf and drip irrigation; assigned watering days are based on each customer's address. To find your assigned watering group, visit changeyourclock.com. Sunday watering is prohibited year-round. In addition, watering with spray irrigation outside of your assigned watering day is considered water waste, which may result in a water-waste fee. Customers also are reminded to change the clocks on their irrigation timers and adjust their irrigation start times now that Daylight Saving Time is in effect. The SNWA is a not-for-profit regional entity that manages water conservation, water quality and water resource issues for Southern Nevada. Its members include: The Big Bend Water District (Laughlin); the cities of Boulder City, Henderson, Las Vegas and North Las Vegas; the Clark County Water Reclamation District; and the Las Vegas Valley Water District.
