



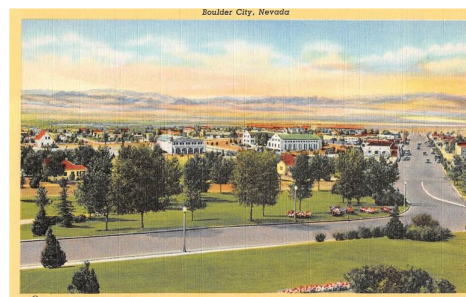

NEIGHBORHOOD PATROLS: Patrol the City in marked "Volunteer" vehicle and on foot as the "eyes and ears" of the Police Department. Volunteers work in pairs and report suspicious conduct to BCPD.

NEIGHBORHOOD SPEED WATCH: Volunteers record license numbers of cars traveling in excess of speed limits. Vehicle owners receive a courtesy letter from BCPD encouraging them to slow down.

VACATION HOME CHECKS: Volunteers conduct physical checks of the exterior of the home for unlocked doors, open windows or anything else out of the ordinary and/or suspicious.

TRAFFIC HAZARDS PATROL: Conduct patrols and identify traffic hazards such as non-functioning street lights, traffic control lights, obstructed street signs, missing manhole covers, potholes and more.

YOU ARE NOT ALONE: Check on senior residents who may be in need of support or just a friendly visit.
