Ryan Bodily was born and raised in the Bay Area and lived there until he moved to the Vegas Valley in 2000. Open Enrollment



**Teamsters Security Fund

Starting October 15th, employees can login to www.teamsters14healthfund.com to complete their open enrollment/spousal affidavit. Open enrollment is a once-a-year opportunity to review current plan elections and covered dependents, enroll in or change the medical and/or dental plan,

add or drop eligible dependents and update their beneficiary information. Changes made during open enrollment each year are effective January 1st of the following year. Outside of Open Enrollment, participants are only able to make changes within 60 days of experiencing a life qualifying event such as marriage or birth of a child. **Please note** that Open Enrollment is only available until November 15th.
