



Boulder City Facilities Review Workshop



The City's inventory of facilities includes a number of buildings with historical significance, many of which have undergone renovations over many years in order to accommodate modern City services. Some buildings have reached an age where significant maintenance and/or upgrades are required. A number of facilities have safety, security, and accessibility issues that need immediate attention. The City of Boulder City initiated the Facilities Assessment and Recommendations to evaluate current and projected requirements for critical City functions and City partners, highest and best use of the currently owned City properties, and recommended directions for use of those properties to meet the City's space and operational requirements over the next ten years.
