Phase Two of Nevada Recovery Announced



Last week, the State entered Phase Two of the pandemic recovery. In a video message, Mayor Kiernan McManus thanked City staff, businesses and the community for cautiously completing Phase One and planning well for Phases Two and beyond. "A great deal of that is going to depend on us doing our part to not only keep ourselves safe, but those around us safe," Mayor McManus said. "The guidelines continue: maintain social distancing, wear a face covering or mask when you're out in public, and

be respectful of what other people are going through in their lives. It's important to understand the reason we're taking these precautions is not for just for us individually, but also for those around us."
