GFOA Recognizes Boulder City's Financial Transparency



The City of Boulder City received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting by Government Finance Officers Association of the United States and Canada (GFOA). The recognition is for the City's Comprehensive Annual Financial Report (CAFR) for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2019. This is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting. "My goal since arriving in Boulder City was to provide the clearest, most transparent financial data for the community. Receiving this award shows a true team effort as we put together our Comprehensive Annual Fund Report," said Diane Pelletier, Finance Director for Boulder City. "We have a team of professionals who go above and beyond for the residents of Boulder City. I'm proud of the hard work and dedication of this staff." The CAFR has been judged by an impartial panel to meet the high standards of the program, which includes demonstrating a constructive "spirit of full disclosure" to clearly communicate its financial story and motivate potential users and user groups to read the CAFR. "The public relies on us to be fiscally responsible, especially at a time when the COVID-19 pandemic is impacting communities worldwide," said Al Noyola, City Manager.
