## Beware of Phone Scams



Phone scams continue to be an issue in Boulder City and beyond. Scam artists are using phone numbers that appear local to try to steal your information. Last week, Jennifer Rogers (Fire Department) received a phone call from someone claiming to be with the Social Security Administration. “The name that came up was ‘Scott Young’ and the telephone number 702-293-xxxx. The message states that they are calling from the Social Security Administration and that my social security number has been used for suspicious activities, and that in order to not be charged, I must press one to speak to an investigator and get the claim number,” Jennifer said. She pressed one and received a bit of a runaround. “He hung up on me. I tried calling the number back and got a very loud noise.” If you get a call like this, the best reaction is to just hang up. The Social Security Administration does not call individuals regarding suspicious activities.
