BCPD is Joining Forces against Speeders



One-third of fatal crashes nationwide involve speeding, a statistic that is prompting local law enforcement officers to crack down on aggressive drivers and speeders in Nevada this summer. Boulder City Police are Joining Forces with Nevada law enforcement officers to increase high-visibility patrols between August 22 - September 2, 2020 for motorists exceeding the speed limit. Driving too fast can turn a near miss into a crash, or a fatality. Speeding is one of the most prevalent factors contributing to traffic crashes and at a tremendous cost. The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration

(NHTSA) estimates that the annual cost to society of speeding-related crashes is \$40.4 billion.
