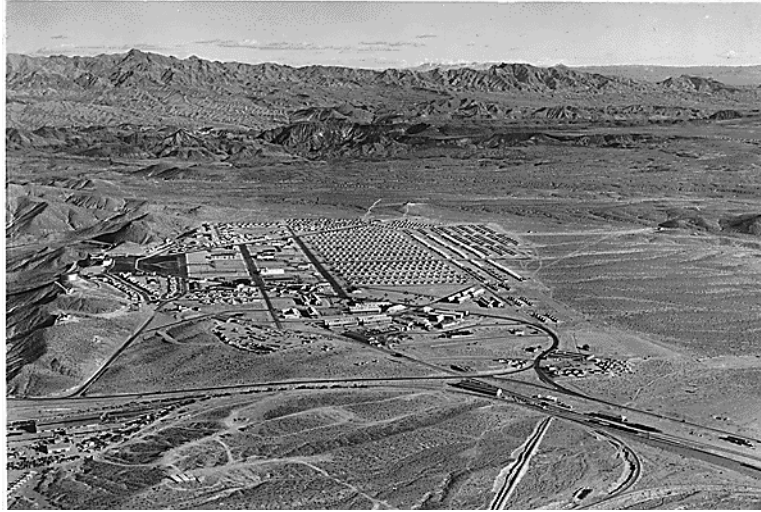


Boulder City Historic Preservation Month

Boulder City, in partnership with the Southern Nevada Health District and Boulder City Hospital, continues to offer free COVID-19 nasal swab testing* through the month of October. No doctors orders are required.

By appointment only on Tuesdays:
