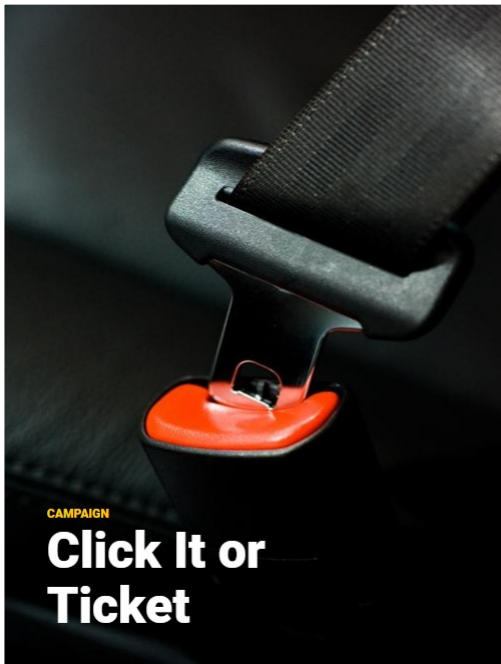


## Click It or Ticket Starts Today



It is a simple habit that takes a matter of seconds and is proven to save lives: seat belt use. Boulder City Police Department is Joining Forces with law enforcement agencies throughout Southern Nevada to make sure drivers “Click It or Ticket” from November 9 through November 21, 2020. “Many of the injuries that we investigate happen in crashes when victims are thrown about a car,” said Boulder City Police Chief Tim Shea. “These injuries can be critical – even deadly. Taking a few moments to make sure everyone in a vehicle is wearing a seatbelt can be a life-or-death decision. We hope that by sharing the Click It or Ticket campaign and by having extra patrols on the roads, drivers will exercise better judgement and drive safely.” Seat belt violations are a secondary offense and can cost hundreds of dollars on top of other citations. According to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, the national seatbelt use rate was more than 90 percent in 2019, and seat belt use in passenger vehicles saved an estimated 14,955 lives in 2017.
