



What's Happening around the City of Boulder City

Acting City Manager and Acting City Attorney Named



City Council voted last week to appoint two acting leadership roles: Acting City Manager and Acting City Attorney. Community Development Director Michael Mays, AICP was selected for the role of acting city manager. Michael has been working for Boulder City since September 2017. He has 25 years municipal planning experience and 17 years management experience.

And welcome to Brittany Lee Walker, Esq. - named acting city attorney. Her experience includes working for Holland & Hart LLP, Las Vegas, NV as an Associate and in the Nevada Court of Appeals for Chief Judge Abbi Silver. She graduated from William S. Boyd School of Law, University of

Nevada, Las Vegas in May 2017. She is licensed to practice in Arizona and Nevada. Both started working in their roles last week. Council also voted to direct staff to look for an executive firm to handle recruitment of replacements for the two roles. The process is expected to take 4-6 months.

Teamsters Open Enrollment Ends Soon

The deadline for Teamsters medical and dental benefits enrollment is November 15, 2020. Outside of open enrollment, you cannot make changes to your plan elections during the year. Coverage-level changes are allowed at other times of the year only if you experience a qualifying life event (such as getting married or divorced, having a baby, or your spouse losing coverage under his or her own plan) but you must make the changes within 60 days of experiencing the qualifying life event. If participants do not want to make any changes to their benefits, they do not need to complete the process; however, **anyone who has a spouse currently enrolled and eligible on the plan must complete the spousal affidavit or their spouses medical and prescription coverage will terminate January 1, 2021.** Participants can access open enrollment at www.teamsters14healthfund.com. Open Enrollment

October 15 – November 15, 2020

What You Need to Know...

- **Open enrollment is your once-a-year opportunity** to change your medical and dental elections. Changes you make take effect January 1, 2021.
- **Required!** To cover your spouse in 2021, you must submit a spousal affidavit.
- **Starting October 15**, log in to teamsters14healthfund.com to complete your open enrollment elections and spousal affidavit.

What if... You Don't Enroll?

You and your covered children will have the same coverage for 2021 as you do now. If you're married and you don't complete the online spousal affidavit by November 15, your spouse will lose medical coverage on January 1, 2021.
