## BC Grant Program for Small Businesses Open through October 30



In September, the City Council of Boulder City set aside federal funds from the COVID-19 Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act Relief Funds for local businesses. Many businesses located within Boulder City with a current business license can apply for a grant using federal CARES Act Relief Funds. A total of \$190,000 will be available to provide operational support to small businesses. Eligible grant uses include working capital (rent, utilities, inventory, payroll, license fees, etc.) or the purchase of supplies and

equipment (personal protective equipment, sanitizers, plexiglass partitions, etc.) to protect customers and employees and slow the spread of the virus. Grant applications will be accepted until October 30, 2020 at midnight. Businesses that have not received federal assistance will be prioritized, but will not be disqualified if it received federal assistance through the Payroll Protection Program or any other assistance program. ## Public Attendance Allowed at More Meetings



Since March, the City of Boulder City has either prohibited or limited attendance at public meetings, carrying them online to promote the safety and well-being of residents and staff. Starting October 22, visitors may attend all Committee and Commission meetings at City Hall, but must still RSVP in advance and follow specific guidelines. Staff and visitors should remain six feet from others if there is no protective barrier (i.e. customer service window) to separate individuals. The City Council Chambers allows

for up to 15 visitors, with preference given to those who have business on the agenda.
