## Statewide Pause Declared by Governor Sisolak



Nevada Governor Steve Sisolak announced new restrictions to help slow the spread of COVID-19. The measures go into effect on Tuesday and will last for the next three weeks. Under the new measures, restaurants, bars, gaming operations, gyms, fitness facilities and other businesses and activities will be limited to 25 percent of applicable fire code capacity, down from 50 percent. No large events will be approved during this time frame and private gatherings will be limited to ten people from no more than two separate households.
