COVID-19 Vaccination Clinics

Boulder City Fire Department, in partnership with Boulder City Hospital, will administer free Moderna vaccines according to the “lanes” set by the State of Nevada.



Boulder City residents only. By appointment only. Call 702.293.9256 Monday-Thursday 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. to make an appointment. **DO NOT LEAVE A MESSAGE, SEND EMAILS OR CALL OTHER STAFF:** You must speak directly with a scheduler to secure an appointment.

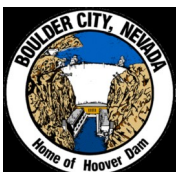
Clinics will be held at
the Elaine K. Smith Building, 700 Wyoming, and
Boulder City Hospital, 901 Adams Blvd, in Boulder City

Starting January 25, 2021:

- Monday through Thursday, 8 a.m.-noon and 1 p.m.-3 p.m.
- People 70 years of age and older (required to show valid ID)
- Educators (required to show a valid school system ID)
- You will be required to stay at the clinic for at least 15 minutes after vaccine.
- Not available if you have tested positive for COVID -19 within the past 90 days.
- Those without an appointment will be refused.
- The next lane, residents 65-69, to be announced soon.

2021 Municipal Election

The City is required to conduct the 2021 Municipal Election under the guidelines of AB4 signed by Governor Sisolak in August 2020. AB4 enacts provisions for conducting elections adversely affected by emergencies or disaster, including COVID-19. The 2021 Municipal Election will be conducted in the same manner as the 2020 Elections. All active registered Boulder City voters will receive a mail ballot, whether or not it was requested. Voters will also have in-person voting options, including early voting.



CLOSE OF REGISTRATION

Are you registered to vote? Have you moved? Be sure your voter registration is up to date. The last day to register to vote or update existing registration either by mail or in person for the April 6, 2021 Municipal Primary Election is March 9, 2021. You may still register to vote or update your existing registration after the standard close of registration, either online at the Secretary of State's website at www.registertovotenv.gov or in person at the early voting site or Election Day Vote Center.
