



Teddy Bear Program Launches at BCFD

Boulder City Fire Department recently started a "Trauma Teddy Program" to help children during traumatic situations. As part of their Community Risk Reduction (CRR) Program, CRR members Deputy Fire Chief Greg Chesser and Firefighter Brian Shea developed another way to help children and families cope with traumatic circumstances. BCFD will keep a supply on hand to help soothe children during fires and/or medical emergencies. "The teddy bear program is designed to bring a little comfort to people, especially young kids, during a traumatic event. Our hope is to bring them a little comfort," said Fire Chief Will Gray. "We are developing

programs that can reduce the risks to life and property within our community. These programs include community first aid and CPR classes, fire prevention and public education, and smoke detector installations. Some of these programs had existed in the past and are being brought back with an added emphasis on the identified risks with Boulder City."
