## Task Force Works to Keep Highways Safe



Boulder City Police Department's motorcycle officers participated in the Southern Nevada Traffic Task Force (SNTTF) last week. The purpose is similar to Joining Forces, with high visibility saturation in a traffic problem area. BCPD worked with officers from Nevada Highway Patrol, Las Vegas Metro, Henderson, North Las Vegas and Clark County School District to help curb bad driving behaviors in problem areas. ## COVID Testing Moves to Bullock Field (Airport Hangar)



Starting tomorrow, March 30, COVID Rapid Testing will be conducted west of the fire station, in the old Bullock Airfield area. Entrance for testing will be at Bullock Field Dr. From there, proceed into the dirt area, then left toward the fire station. The Boulder City Police Command Unit is the test location. The move should help reduce traffic congestion and potential accidents around the fire station. Testing is on Tuesdays only, from 8 a.m.-noon and 1 p.m.-3 p.m. No appointment necessary.
