## COVID-19 Vaccinations Open to 18+

Boulder City Fire Department and Boulder City Hospital are vaccinating all individuals ages 18 years and up. The City provides the Moderna vaccine, which can only be given to those 18 and older. For those individuals ages 16 & 17, check with a health care provider or retail pharmacy for options. The Southern Nevada Health District says that 34% of Boulder City residents have received at least one dose, compared to Clark County at 26%. They estimate 24.5% have completed the vaccinations compared to Clark County at 14.4%.



- Total vaccinated doses given in Clark County: 914,809
- Total first doses in Clark County: 602,334
- Total completed vaccinations in Clark County: 333,565
- Total vaccination doses given in Boulder City: 9,301+ (exact number unknown as vaccinations are occurring at the clinic, BC Hospital, and the pharmacies for people within Boulder City and greater Clark County)
- Total Boulder City residents with at least one dose: 5,414
- Boulder City residents with completed vaccinations: 3,887

Vaccines are free and by appointment only. Currently, there are appointment times available for Wednesday and Friday. If you know someone looking to receive the vaccine, have them call 702.293.9256 M-Th from 8 a.m. until 3 p.m.
