



2021 NV Legislative Session a Success for Boulder City



The Nevada Legislature adjourned sine die on May 31, 2021. Boulder City was well-represented in Carson City by Foster Consulting and City Attorney Brittany Walker. They ensured the City's voice was heard on the various measures being considered. As an example, our Boulder City representatives were able to secure an amendment at the eleventh hour on Assembly Bill 363 that would have infringed upon Boulder City's authority to regulate short-term vacation rentals (i.e. AirBNB's, VRBO's). The City will provide a detailed report on the impact of the 81st Nevada Legislative Session later this summer.

World's Largest Swim Lesson Returns to Boulder City



Boulder City youth and adults will join tens of thousands of swimmers at aquatic facilities around the world for the World's Largest Swimming Lesson™ (WLSL). On Thursday, June 17, 2021, from noon until 1:00 p.m., swimmers of all experience levels will do their part to raise awareness of water safety. The international event will be held at an estimated

600 locations in more than 20 countries. "Last year, COVID-19 kept so many of our children out of the pools," said Cheree Brennan, Boulder City Aquatics Coordinator. "We have some catching up to do with our young swimmers, and this is a great way to make up for that lost time." In the event's 13 years, about 320,000 children and adults have participated in WLSL lessons. Drowning is the leading cause of unintended, injury related death for children ages one to four - the second leading cause of accidental death for children under 14 - in the U.S. Research shows that swimming lessons can reduce the risk of drowning by 88% among children ages one to four.
