Any registered voter who is eligible to vote in this election will receive a mail ballot for the June 15, 2021 Municipal General Election, whether or not they requested one. Mail ballot drop-off sites will be included in your mail ballot packet. If you wish to vote in person instead of by mail, you may surrender your mail ballot at the Early Voting location and vote in person. Early Voting Schedule:

- Thursday, June 3 7 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- Friday – Sunday, June 4 – June 6 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- Monday – Thurs, June 7 – June 10 7 a.m. – 6 p.m.
- Friday, June 11 8 a.m. – 6 p.m.

Municipal General Election Day is June 15, 2021. The deadline to receive and/or cure ballots is 5:00 p.m. on June 24, 2021. Unofficial Results will be provided after the deadline on June 24, 2021. Official Results will be canvassed on June 28, 2021 at 9:00 a.m.
