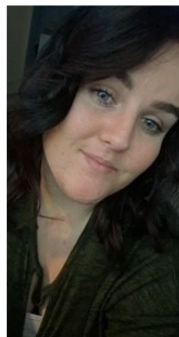




Welcome to BCPD New Hires!
