Drought conditions have reached a critical point in the southwest. Water conservation is a must as Lake Mead water levels continue to decline. The entire region is looking at ways to conserve, while exhibiting the natural beauty of trees, shrubs, plants and flowers. Staff at the City of Boulder City are looking for input from residents and business owners on how to balance the two issues. Boulder City Code provides requirements for new development landscaping. Current landscaping of businesses would not need to change their current landscaping, and private homeowners can still plant what they choose on their property. The city is working with a landscape architect consultant to develop new landscape requirements for new development and guidance for parkway landscaping. 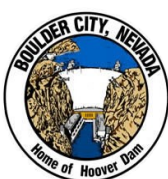
Upcoming Meetings and Workshops
